The Clark County Department of Aviation is the largest department within the government of Clark County, Nevada. McCarran International Airport and the four general aviation facilities in the Clark County Airport System are owned by Clark County and operated under the policy direction of the Board of County Commissioners, the authority of the County Manager and the management of the Director and Deputy Directors of Aviation.

Ms. Shaw brings more than 20 years of experience in the planning, development, implementation and management of concession programs at four of the top ten airports in the United States. She has worked for the Clark County Department of Aviation as Airport Program Administrator/Manager of Concessions and Small Business Program since 2016 and as the Airport DBE/ACDBE Liaison. Ms. Shaw worked for Los Angeles World Airports from 2008 to 2010 as Deputy Executive Director/Manager and Concessions Development and from 2004 to 2008 for the Port of Seattle as Manager, Aviation Commercial Business. From 1995 to 2004, she was the Manager of Concessions for Denver International Airport. Ms. Shaw received a Bachelor of Science in Business Management from University of Phoenix.
