The Burbank-Glendale-Pasadena Airport Authority has selected Patrick Lammerding as Deputy Executive Director of Planning & Development for the Hollywood Burbank Airport. In this position, he will oversee maintenance, engineering, environmental, planning, design and construction services. Mr. Lammerding will also be responsible for developing and implementing the airport's current fiscal year Capital Construction Plan, and updating the four-year look-ahead Capital Plan. He will coordinate with governing regulatory and funding agencies on designated capital projects; manage outside consultants on capital projects being managed by the engineering department; oversee contractors and other entities engaged in construction services as part of the execution of the Airport's Capital Construction Plan; and manage, monitor and assure that all engineering project deliverables comply with all governing code and regulatory requirements.
