THE AIRPORT

CRAA is a regional authority which owns and operates Capital Region International Airport (LAN) in Lansing Michigan. LAN employs approximately 43 people with an annual budget approaching \$14 million and annual passengers of approximately 385,000. The Airport is also the home of Port Lansing, including a U.S. Customs & Border Protection Federal Inspection Station for the clearance of international passengers and cargo, as well as an 850-acre co-located Foreign Trade Zone. CRAA also owns and operates a general aviation airport called Mason Jewett Field located in Mason, Michigan.
