

The Martha's Vineyard Airport Commission Selects New Airport Manager

MARTHA'S VINEYARD – Following a nationwide search, the Martha's Vineyard Airport Commission has selected Ann Crook, A.A.E., to be the new Airport Manager at the Martha's Vineyard Airport (MVY). An agreement was reached with Crook on April 4, after the commission interviewed three final candidates who were being considered for the position.

In her new role, Crook will operate the airport, the airport business park, manage aviation and non-aviation tenants, airport water and waste water services, implement policy, and ensure compliance with state and federal guidelines for public airports.

In her current position, Crook is the Director of Aviation of the Elmira Corning Regional Airport.

In 2000, Crook was appointed by the Governor as the first Director of the new Oregon Department of Aviation. An accredited airport executive, Crook has also been the Operations Manager at the Eugene Airport in Oregon, Manager of the Hutchinson Airport in Kansas, Manager of the State of Oregon's 36 airports, and Director of the Klamath Falls Airport in Oregon.
