

The Metropolitan Nashville Airport Authority Announces New Chief Financial Officer

NASHVILLE, TN – Marge Basrai, CPA, CGMA, C.M., has been named the new Chief Financial Officer for the Metropolitan Nashville Airport Authority (MNAA). MNAA was established in 1970, and owns and operates Nashville International Airport (BNA) and John C. Tune Airport (JWN).
