

## The Metropolitan Nashville Airport Authority Announces New Director, Design

NASHVILLE, TN – The Metropolitan Nashville Airport Authority (MNA) has appointed Matthew Cramer as Director, Design. In this role, he will oversee the civil and architectural design work for MNA and ensure the capital program is executed within scope, schedule, and budget. MNA was established in 1970 and owns and operates Nashville International Airport (BNA) and John C. Tune Airport (JWN).
