## Job Description

The Director of Airports plans, organizes and directs the operations, planning, budgets, national and state grants, public relations and marketing, for the airport system in Horry County. The Director administers policies and directives of Horry County as well as plans, directs, and coordinates the work of all airport employees.

## Requirements

The superior candidate will have, as a minimum, a Bachelor's degree in Airport Management, Business Administration or closely related field. To be considered, you will be currently employed in the number one or number two position at an airport and have a minimum of ten (10) years of progressive management experience at a commercial service airport. A.A.E. accreditation is definitely a plus.

## The Airport

The Myrtle Beach International Airport (MYR) is owned by Horry County and operated by the Department of Airports. Enplanements in 2008 were 705,430. In addition, the Department is responsible for three general aviation airports in the area.

MYR is conveniently located close to the attractions that make Myrtle Beach, S.C., a popular tourist destination – 60 miles of beach called the "Grand Strand" and numerous golf courses. MYR is served by 7 airlines: Delta, Continental, American, Allegiant, Spirit Airlines, US Airways, and United, offering daily, nonstop flights to over 20 destinations. The airport is in the midst of a redevelopment and expansion plan that will add a new terminal complex and renovate existing terminal facilities in order to better accommodate projected passenger levels.

The airport, as directed by County Council, is developing a program to increase passenger capacity on the east side of the airport. The project, called "MYR Terminal Capacity Enhancement Project" is a proposed \$129 million project that will expand the current commercial terminal from 7 gates to 12 and will include new parking facilities, and new, separate car rental building, and updates to the current passenger terminal.
