OGDEN, UT – The Ogden City Corporation appointed Bryant Garrett as the new Airport Manager for the Ogden-Hinckley Airport (OGD) effective Jan. 28, 2019. In this role, Mr. Garrett will be responsible for the administration, planning, development and direction of operations at OGD, Utah’s busiest municipal airport for private planes.

Prior to joining OGD, Mr. Garrett was the Airports Manager for the City of Redding, California, where he was responsible for the operations, finance and management of the two city-owned airports, Redding Municipal Airport (RDD) and Benton Air Park (O85). Mr. Garrett has also worked for the Sanford Airport Authority and the Salt Lake City Airport Authority.

“I am honored to accept the Airport Manager position for the City of Ogden,” said Mr. Garrett. “This is going back home for me. I received my pilot’s license at OGD in 1983. I look forward to joining a great team, both at the airport and with the city.”

Mr. Garrett received a bachelor’s degree in Air Operations Management from Westminster College and a master’s degree in Public Administration from Brigham Young University. He is an Accredited Member (A.A.E.) of the American Association of Airport Executives.
