

The Indianapolis Airport Authority Announces New Senior Director of Planning and Development

INDIANAPOLIS, IN – Jarod Klaas has been named the new Senior Director of Planning and Development for the Indianapolis Airport Authority (IAA). IAA owns, develops, and operates six airports in the Indianapolis metropolitan area, including Indianapolis International Airport (IND), the first new international airport in America designed and built after 9/11.

As Senior Director, Mr. Klaas is responsible for conceptualizing, developing, and overseeing proactive and strategically driven initiatives regarding master planning, project management, engineering, and environmental and conservation matters. He will manage all capital projects, environmental, planning, and development risks and opportunities of IAA, both internally and externally.

Mr. Klaas brings over 21 years of relevant leadership experience in a combination of airport, city government, consulting, and utility positions. He most recently served as the Interim Senior Director of Planning and Development for Indianapolis Airport Authority and has also served as Director of Engineering. In addition, Mr. Klaas worked for the Wabash Valley Power Association, KERAMIDA Environmental, Inc., the Department of Public Works and the Indiana Dept. of Natural Resources. He earned a Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering from Purdue University and a Master of Business Administration from Indiana Wesleyan University. Mr. Klaas is also a Professional Engineer.
