### PURPOSE OF THIS ROLE

The Director of Air Service Development functions as a key member of the Communications, Government and Community Affairs Division and will be charged with developing and executing strategic objectives, key initiatives, and tactical plans to retain, improve, and expand air service and increase airport use.

# **OUALIFICATIONS**

To qualify for this position, an applicant should have:

- Seven years of work experience in aviation (preferred)
- At least three years of experience directly related to aviation industry planning, market research and analysis, airline sales, marketing and network planning/scheduling, or a combination of the above
- Five years of air service experience managing multiple projects Knowledge of the principles and practices of market research and trade analysis
- Ability to use US DOT and Bureau of Information Statistics databases
- Knowledge of quantitative modeling and evaluation methodologies
- Ability to prepare clear, concise correspondence and written reports from market research
- Ability to develop, manage, organize, and update computer databases
- Ability to plan and schedule work activities, ensuring that priorities are maintained and projects are completed accurately and on time
- Ability to travel domestically and internationally as needed

 Bachelor's degree (master's preferred) in marketing, business administration, international commerce, aviation management or related

## **Essential Duties**

- Works with network planning, scheduling and marketing representatives of domestic and international airlines, corporate customers, research agencies, peer airports, professional airport trade associations, government representatives and business leaders
- Maintains awareness of airport capacities and plans
- Conducts research and identifies passenger, cargo, general aviation, and regional needs
- Monitors schedules, fares, and frequencies; identifies air service target markets for service improvements and participates in air service forecasting
- Works with the air carrier community and corporate travel managers within the RDU catchment area throughout the Triangle, central, and eastern NC
- Works collaboratively with economic development and inbound tourism developers
- Monitors state, federal and international aviation issues, global air carrier alliances, and regulations impacting air carrier services
- Performs fundamental statistical analysis of USDOT and other air service data sources
- Develops and implements strategies to support retention and acquisition of air services
  Conducts research on and identifies target markets for service increases
- Engages consultants to assist with analytical business cases
- Recommends and implements air service development policy and marketing programs
- Assesses and promotes regional NC market assets
- Advocates for RDU and represents interests in bilateral agreement proceedings
- Conceives, gains approval, and supervises execution of air service development plans
- Projects RDU traffic, issues, and trends
- Gathers data from RDU passengers on potential local air service needs
- Develops and implements marketing plans to target potential business for the airport
- Works on presentations for domestic and international passenger service
- Serve as member of the Crisis Communications Management Team, which manages airport communications to internal and external audiences during irregular and emergency operations
- Completes related work as assigned
