## The Airport

**Southwest Oregon Regional Airport**, formerly North Bend Municipal Airport, is a public airport in North Bend, Coos County, Oregon. It is operated by the Coos County Airport District. OTH covers 430 acres of land and is the only airport on the Oregon Coast with scheduled passenger service. The airport offers easy access between Southwest Oregon Regional Airport and Oregon's south coast via Hwy 101.

Located in one of the most pristine places there could be to live, work, play, and experience life, the Southwest Oregon Regional Airport is your Gateway to Southern Oregon. Southwest Oregon Regional Airport is committed to providing safe and effective facilities to airport customers.

United Airlines flies to San Francisco daily and offers a seasonal flight to Denver on Wednesdays and Sundays from May to September. Coos Aviation is the FBO operator at the airport.

Additional operators at the airport include Reach Air Medical and two rental car agencies, UPS, FedEx and the United States Coast Guard.

The airport experienced 13,393 passenger enplanements and approximately 18,615 aircraft operations in 2019.

## The Community

**North Bend** is a city in Coos County, Oregon. North Bend is surrounded on three sides by Coos Bay, an S-shaped water inlet and estuary where the Coos River enters Coos Bay and borders the city of Coos Bay to the south. North Bend became an incorporated city in 1903.

Driving from the north down Highway 101, the majestic McCullough Bridge ushers travelers into the city of North Bend. The area was once a timber hub where daily life was built around the harbor and sawmill. Now Main Street, just down the road from the bridge, features walkable streets with shops, restaurants, and cafés tucked amidst those same hallmarks of Pacific Northwest life.

Today North Bend is home to almost 10,000 people and proudly boasts the Southwest Oregon Regional Airport (the Oregon Coast’s only airport), the Oregon Coast’s largest enclosed shopping mall, Pony Village Mall, and the historic McCullough Bridge. You’ll also find Horsfall Beach and the North Spit, named as one of Sunset Magazine’s top ten beach strolls in the western region, and the Oregon Dunes National Recreation Area, home of the towering 500-foot sand dunes and some of the most amazing ATV and off-roading opportunities to be found.

## The Bay Area

The Bay Area and the Oregon Coast are replete with natural beauty. Pristine beaches, clean rivers, dense forests and mild climate are just the starters. And in just a few short hours’ drive there are Alpine lakes, ski slopes and the city of Portland, a delightful cosmopolitan city.

When one thinks of the Oregon Coast, one thinks quality of life. The area is unequalled in outdoor recreation opportunities. Within less than an hour’s drive there are more than a dozen government parks and campgrounds, warm water lakes, miles of gorgeous beaches, hiking trails through primeval rainforests, excellent fishing, crabbing and clamming. If your interests lie more to the hunter-gatherer side, there is outstanding hunting for deer, elk, bear, waterfowl and upland game birds. *(continued...)*

The fishing opportunities are plentiful almost year-round and include salmon, largemouth bass, giant sturgeon, trout, as well as dozens of species of saltwater delicacies. For campers and outdoor adventurers there are 40 miles of sand dunes to buzz through in your ATV and a whole range of mountains with miles of back roads to explore.

Live in town or out in the country and your drivetime is a convenient drive to the office or shopping. Between the Bay Area and Bandon (23 miles to the south) there are a plethora of restaurants offering fine dining and more than enough of the casual sort to satisfy any appetite.

The area is a golf mecca, featuring Bandon Dunes, one of the top destinations for golf enthusiasts from all over. Golf was born on rugged, wind-swept land just like this. Every hole, every hazard, every shot is defined by nature's infinite presence. As the elements change, so does the game. It's all part of the tradition of links golf. ### Fishing

Coos Bay offers one of the most productive fishing hotspots for perch of any of Oregon's bays. Fish along the channels that drain the tidal flats associated with South Slough, West Coos Bay up through the Jordan Cove and along the riprap associated the North Bend Airport.

### Dunes & Beaches

Whether you simply want to enjoy the views or arrive with your off-road vehicle, the famous sand dunes stretch close to 40 miles of coastline spanning from the Coos River (North Bend, OR) to the Siuslaw River (Florence, OR). The Oregon Dunes National Recreation Area is a special place. One of the largest expanses of temperate coastal sand dunes in the world, the stark, mist-shrouded views of dunes, forests, and ocean in such close proximity to one another are rare and hauntingly beautiful.

Explore stunning secluded sandy inlets enclosed by spectacular eroded sedimentary rocks and hike photogenic trails and paths. It's an outdoor paradise.
