The Moore County Airport Authority Appoints Rick Cloutier, C.M., Airport Director

COLUMBUS, OH – The Moore County Airport Authority has named Rick Cloutier, C.M., Airport Director effective October 1. In this position, he will manage all activities of Moore County Airport (SOP) and the airport's exclusive fixed based operator. Mr. Cloutier will replace current director Ron Maness who is retiring in October.

Mr. Cloutier has had a career in airport management since 2006 in Maine, North Carolina and Idaho, where he has developed and executed operations administration plans for the facilities. He oversaw the management at the Auburn-Lewiston Municipal Airport in Maine and later moved to Concord Regional Airport, where he was instrumental in developing commercial air service. Most recently he was Airport Director at Idaho Falls Regional Airport, where he expanded commercial services and developed more than \$150 million in airport grants for the facility.
