The City of Dallas Names Patrick Carreno as Director of Aviation

DALLAS, TX – The City of Dallas has named Patrick Carreno Director of Aviation overseeing Dallas Love Field (DAL), Dallas Executive Airport (RBD) and the Dallas Vertiport (JDB). In this position, he will be responsible for aviation operations, administration, and personnel management, and ensuring the Airport's effectiveness and efficiency. He began his new position on August 1, 2023.

Mr. Carreno had served as Interim Director since November 2022. Previously he was Assistant Director of Operations and oversaw Airport Security, Airside Operations, and Landside Operations including Terminal Operations and Passenger Support, Ground Transportation, Emergency Management, Transportation Regulation, and the Airport Operations Center divisions.
