The Memphis-Shelby County Airport Authority Appoints Marshall Stevens, A.A.E., Vice President of Operations/COO

MEMPHIS, TN – The Memphis-Shelby County Airport Authority has named Marshall Stevens, A.A.E., Vice President of Operations/Chief Operating Officer. In this role, he will be responsible for the operational objectives of Memphis International Airport (MEM) and will recommend long-range objectives and strategies for the Airport's Operations, Maintenance, Development, Public Safety, and General Aviation functions. He is tentatively scheduled to begin his new position on October 9, 2023.

Mr. Stevens has more than 30 years of aviation experience, serving most recently as the Deputy Executive Director for the Susquehanna Area Regional Airport Authority, a position he has held since March 2008, where he manages Harrisburg International Airport (MDT) and three general aviation airports in Middletown, PA. He served from 1999 to early 2008 as the Airport Manager for the Floyd Bennett

Memorial Airport near Glens Falls, New York, where he was responsible for all aspects of the operation, maintenance, and capital improvement of the airport. Previously Mr. Stevens worked as an airport consultant where he prepared airport master plans, environmental and noise studies, and capital improvement plans.
