The City of Brownsville Appoints Angel Ramos Airport Director

BROWNSVILLE, TX – The City of Brownsville has named Angel Ramos, A.A.E., Airport Director for the Brownsville/South-Padre International Airport (BRO). In this position, he will manage and direct all functions of the airport, including operations, maintenance and security and the airport’s budget and capital improvement program. He will begin his new role on February 20, 2024.
