

The City of San José

Known as the "Capital of Silicon Valley," the City of San José plays a vital economic and cultural role anchoring the world's leading region of innovation. Encompassing approximately 181 square miles at the southern tip of the San Francisco Bay, San José is Northern California's largest city and the 12th largest city in the nation. With nearly one million residents. San José is one of the most diverse large cities in the United States. San José's transformation into a global innovation center has resulted in one of the largest concentrations of technology companies and expertise in the world, including major tech headquarters like Cisco, Adobe, Zoom, Samsung, and eBay as well as start-ups and advanced manufacturing. The City of San José has twice been named "The Most Innovative Large City in America" by the Center for Digital Government.

San José's quality-of-life is unsurpassed. Surrounded by the Diablo and Santa Cruz mountain ranges and enjoying an average of 300 days of sunshine a year, residents have easy access to the beaches along the California coast including Santa Cruz, Monterey, and Carmel; Yosemite and Lake Tahoe in the Sierra Nevada; local and Napa Valley wine country; and the rich cultural and recreational life of the entire Bay region. San José has received accolades for its vibrant neighborhoods, healthy lifestyle, and diverse attractions from national media including Business Week and Money magazines. In 2011, the City adopted Envision San José 2040, a long-term growth plan that sets forth a vision and a comprehensive road map to guide the City's anticipated growth through the year 2040. The Plan, which embodies the City's "more urban future," proactively directs significant anticipated growth in new homes and workplaces into transit-accessible, infill growth areas and supports evolution toward a more urban landscape and lifestyle. The San José area is powered by one of the most highly educated and productive populations in America. More than 40% of the workforce has a bachelor's degree or higher, compared with 25% nationally. Forty percent of San José residents are foreign born, and 50% speak a language other than English at home.

San José is proud of its rich cultural diversity and global connections, and the essential role the City plays in connecting residents and businesses to the nation and the world.

City Government

The City of San José is a full-service Charter City and operates under a Council-Manager form of government. The City Council consists of 10 council members elected by district and a mayor elected at large. The City Manager, who reports to the Council, and her executive team provide strategic leadership that supports the policy-making role of the Mayor and the City Council and motivates and challenges the organization to deliver high quality services that meet the community's needs. The City also actively engages with the community through Council-appointed boards and commissions.


In addition to providing a full range of municipal services including police and fire, San José operates an airport, municipal water system, a regional wastewater treatment facility, some 200 neighborhood and regional parks, and a library system with 24 branches. The City also oversees convention, cultural, and hospitality facilities that include the San José McEnery Convention Center, Center for the Performing Arts, California Theater, Mexican Heritage Plaza, and the SAP Center San José – home of the National Hockey League's San José Sharks.



Key attributes include proven abilities in managing change, maintaining strong relationships with stakeholders, sustaining exceptional teams, and serving as an industry leader.







The Airport and The Position

Fueled by a culture of innovation, San José Mineta International Airport (SJC) is the Bay Area's easiest and most dependable airport due to its medium size, simple layout, temperate climate, and inland location. SJC is located just minutes from downtown San José– the Bay Area's largest city and the Capital of Silicon Valley. In 2023, SJC was rated the Best Airport in the U.S. by Wall Street Journal and Best Midsize U.S. Airport in North America by travelers in the Airports Council International Airport Service Quality (ASQ) program.

SJC welcomed more than 12 million passengers in 2023. The Airport's two passenger terminals offer 36 gates equipped with passenger boarding bridges, including four swing gates connected to a U.S. Federal Inspection Services facility. The Airport's 10 commercial airline partners serve more than 40 nonstop destinations across North America and in Asia. SJC's two fixed-base operators, as well as several corporate aviation tenants, serve the business aviation needs of Silicon Valley; corporate and general aviation traffic represents more than a quarter of aircraft operations at the Airport. With a compact footprint of just 1095 acres, SJC's two, parallel 11,000 ft. runways are a short taxi from both the passenger terminals and the general aviation ramp.

The airport's mission is to connect, serve and inspire. Supporting this work is a staff of 228 with a 2023-2024 <u>annual operating budget</u> of \$176 million and a 2024-2028 <u>Capital Improvement Program</u> of \$614 million. SJC is a self-supporting enterprise operation that receives no direct General Fund support from the City. The San José City Council is the policy making body for SJC. The Airport has an 11-member Airport Commission appointed by the Mayor and City Council that serves

in an advisory capacity to the City Council and to the Director of Aviation regarding airport issues. The City's Airport Commission activity can be reviewed <u>here</u>. SJC is a department in the Transportation and Aviation City Service Area. The City's Aviation Director reports to and serves as a key advisor to the City Manager. The Aviation Director's Executive Management Team includes an Assistant Director and five Deputy Directors. They steward Airport operations and the routes serving the greater Silicon Valley community; maintain partnerships with the Federal Aviation Administration and business community; and champion the air transportation for San José residents. The Aviation Director also is a vital member of City interdepartmental teams leading the major infrastructure direction of the City as well as those attracting jobs and economic growth.

Our Ideal Candidate

The City of San José has high standards for its leadership team and a record of success. We are looking for demonstrated qualities of strategic thinking, commitment, accountability, integrity, and exceptional levels of technical competency in airport management. The Director of Aviation will exhibit a high level of accountability to the City Manager, City Council, the community, and our employees for results, management, and communication. The Director also will be an active contributing member of the City's executive management team.

SJC's next Director of Aviation will be someone who embraces the value of collaboration, including addressing important issues with community and airline partners, City and Airport management and staff, and the aviation industry; who freely shares information to identify challenges early and find solutions to issues that arise; who embraces creativity and change to improve the quality of service and efficient operations; who appreciates and welcomes San José's rich multicultural, diverse environment; and a proven leader in empowering employees and supporting their development and recognition.


Experience

The critical nature of this position requires that the successful candidate possess superior leadership skills with at least 10 years of increasingly responsible management experience in airport administration, operations, or maintenance, including at least five years of supervision at a level equivalent to Assistant Director. Experience in an airport environment dealing with similar scope and complexities is a differentiator.

Education

A Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college or university in public administration, business administration, or discipline related to airport management is required. A master's degree and/ or Aviation Management Profession credentials are desired, such as A.A.E. certification or IAP accreditation.
