

Lincoln Airport (LNK) – Where Innovation Meets Opportunity

Located in the heart of Nebraska, Lincoln Airport (LNK) is a dynamic, growing aviation hub with a strong commitment to operational excellence and community engagement. The Airport is seeking a dedicated Executive Director to lead and oversee the daily functions of LNK, ensuring efficiency, safety, and seamless service for travelers, tenants, and stakeholders.


The Airport

Lincoln Airport (LNK) is a shared-use public/military airport located just 5 minutes from downtown Lincoln. As Nebraska's second largest and capital city, Lincoln is a thriving community known for its innovation, business-friendly environment, exceptional quality of life and is the proud home of the Nebraska Cornhuskers.

- Air Service: LNK is served by United Airlines, offering daily flights to Chicago and Denver. New service to Orlando begins this winter via Breeze Airlines. LNK also serves as a maintenance base for Skywest Airlines.
- Terminal Modernization: In 2024, LNK completed a \$56 million renovation that expanded the terminal by 38,000 square feet, added two new gates (six total), enhanced passenger amenities, and introduced new post-security food and beverage options.
- Runway Rehabilitation: The Lincoln Airport's primary runway (18/36) is one of the longest civilian runways in the country at 12,901 feet.
 The airport is getting ready to undertake a large co-funded (DOD and FAA) project to completely reconstruct the runway starting in November 2025.
 The project is expected to last through the fall of 2027.
- General Aviation: The Airport is home to multiple, thriving general aviation enterprises, including Hillaero, Silverhawk Aviation, Atlantic Aviation and Duncan Aviation, the world's largest privately owned business jet service provider.
- Military Partnerships: Home to the Nebraska Air National Guard's 155th Air Refueling Wing and the Nebraska Army National Guard's Joint Force Headquarters, LNK also serves as the primary backup for Offutt Air Force Base.



- Strategic Business Hub: The airport operates
 the 1,000+ acre LNK Enterprise Park, an industrial
 park housing manufacturing, warehousing, and
 logistics businesses with direct access to dual rail
 services, several major highways, and Interstate
 80.
- Economic Impact: LNK plays a vital role in supporting regional and national transportation networks while fostering economic development. A 2019 study by NEDOT revealed that LNK was responsible for \$1.3B in annual economic impact to the community of Lincoln. This was confirmed by results of a University of Nebraska study in 2025.
- Lincoln Airport Authority: Governed by a 5-member Board of Directors, the Lincoln Airport is under the care, custody and control of the Lincoln Airport Authority. Members of the Airport Authority Board are elected by the residents of Lincoln to serve 6-year terms.
- LNK Team: The Lincoln Airport has seen sizable growth in the last few years. The team is comprised of just over 100 employees, and they oversee an operating budget (FY25) of just under \$17 million and a capital budget of approximately \$14 million.


Cultural & Recreational Opportunities

- **Pinnacle Bank Arena** (16,000-seat entertainment and sports venue).
- Memorial Stadium: Join 90,000+ Husker fans for an unforgettable experience at iconic Memorial Stadium watching the Nebraska Cornhuskers play football.
- Sheldon Museum of Art & Lied Center of Performing Arts: Home to renowned American art collections and performing arts.
- University of Nebraska-Lincoln: A Big Ten university known for research, innovation, and strong sports traditions.
- Innovation Campus: Connects research with businesses to drive new technologies and startups.
- Sports Hub: Lincoln is home to the Nebraska Cornhuskers, the most recognized brand in college athletics that includes the #1 ranked women's volleyball team in D1 college sports. It also hosts high school championships, minor league baseball (Lincoln Saltdogs), and USHL hockey (Lincoln Stars).
- 128 Miles of Trails: One of the best urban trail systems in the country for biking, walking, and running.
- State Parks & Outdoor Activities: Boating, fishing, and hiking opportunities abound at local parks like Pioneers Park and Branched Oak Lake. Hit the links at one of the 25 public and private golf courses in and around Lincoln.
- Family-Friendly Attractions: Lincoln offers plenty
 of fun for kids of all ages, including the Lincoln
 Children's Zoo with up-close animal encounters
 and interactive exhibits, the Lincoln Children's
 Museum featuring three floors of hands-on exhibits
 and imaginative play, and the region's premier
 museum of natural history, Morril Hall, a 4-level,
 70,000-square-feet museum known especially for
 its iconic Elephant Hall.

 Lincoln offers expertly brewed coffees, exquisite wines, innovative craft beers and unique cocktail creations. From cozy coffee shops to local wineries, breweries and cocktail bars serving everything from refreshing pale ales and bold stouts to Paper Planes and modern day Old Fashioneds, there's something to delight every beverage enthusiast.

Leadership Qualities and Style


