



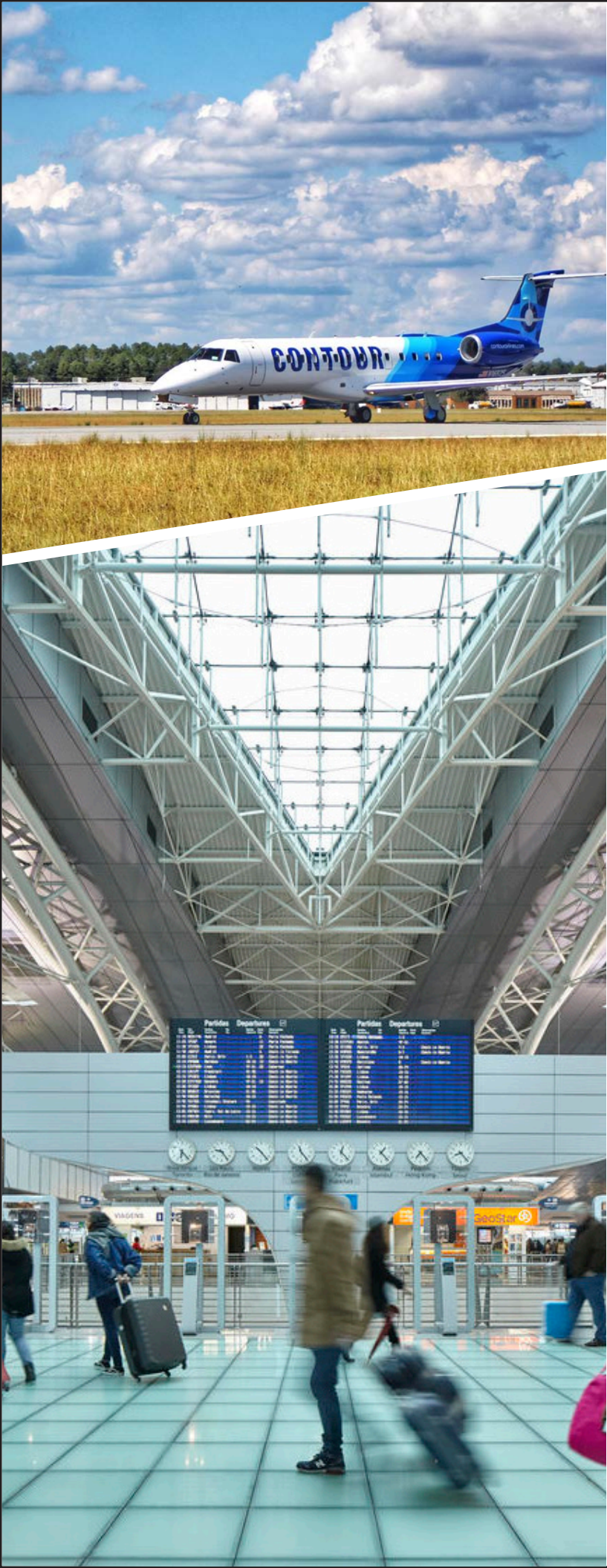

The Organization

TBI Airport Management (TBI AM) is an Atlanta-based airport operator with more than four decades of experience supporting the management and daily functioning of six airports across the United States under long term operation and management agreements with public clients. In 2025 the airports and terminals fully or partially managed by TBI AM welcomed over 41 million passengers.

The company is a wholly-owned subsidiary of VINCI Airports, the world's leading private airport operator. VINCI Airports develops, finances, operates, and maintains a global network of more than 70 airports across 14 countries in Europe, the Americas, and Asia. Within this global platform, VINCI Airports delivers the full spectrum of airport activities, including airside and terminal operations, infrastructure maintenance, commercial development, passenger services, and long-term asset management.

Within this framework, TBI Airport Management provides operational expertise in the United States, with a focus on the safe, efficient, and reliable management of airport operations. TBI AM's core responsibilities center on the operational management of airport infrastructure and services. This includes oversight of airside operations, ramp and gate coordination, operational control center support, and routine airfield inspections to ensure that runways, taxiways, lighting systems, and other critical infrastructure remain safe, compliant, and fully operational.

These responsibilities include maintaining airfield electrical systems, supporting infrastructure maintenance programs, and overseeing general facility management activities. Through these efforts, the organization helps ensure long-term asset performance and operational readiness.

Terminal and passenger-facing operations also play an important role in TBI AM's service delivery. The company provides operational support within terminal environments, including passenger assistance and terminal coordination services that facilitate efficient movement throughout airport facilities while supporting a consistent passenger experience.
